



Château Moulin de Launay Entre-Deux-Mers

BORDEAUX (FRANCE)

Belonging to Claude and Bernard Greffier, the estate is entirely family-run and has produced exclusively dry white wine for four generations. The balance between regional varieties, the constant care given to the vines and improved vinification techniques guarantee the highest quality standards.

They produce a traditional white Bordeaux blend of Sémillon (45%), Sauvignon Blanc (35%) and Muscadelle (20%) that's made in a modern style - cool temperatures, protection from oxygen, early bottling. At an average of 25 years old, the vines here are quite mature for a wine of this type - and mature vines mean better wine, albeit in smaller volumes.

Grapes: Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc, Muscadelle

Alcohol: 12.5% vol.

Appearance: Brilliant pale yellow and straw **Nose**: White floral aromas with ripe citrus and tree

Palate: Nectarine, lemongrass and quince balanced with bright, zesty citrus.

Pairs well with: Oysters!! Shellfish, seafood, grilled pork, salads, light pasta dishes and sheep cheeses.



Bordeaux Wine Region of France

Climate: Bordeaux has a maritime climate and is sheltered by pine forests on both the south and the west. The summers tend to be warm and the winters are relatively mild.

The region of Bordeaux covers a vast amount of area and produces almost 700 million bottles of wine every year. The wines that are produced in Bordeaux (both red and white) are almost always blends of two or more varieties of grapes.

Bordeaux has a very complex system of regional wine classification. Each area within Bordeaux has its own system and specific terminology which adds to the complication. Some classifications are based on estate and not the land. **Entre-Deux-Mers** wines have never been classified, but the name 'Entre-Deux-Mers' can only be used to describe a dry, white, wine.

The most widely planted white varietal of Bordeaux wines is **Sémillon**, which is generally creamy with honey flavors. **Sauvignon Blanc** is the second most common planted white grape, and is acidic, floral, and herbal.
